The programme fee is USD 450.00







Social Enterprise for Economic Development (SEED) 2013 "A Cross - Cultural Leadership Program" UMK and Pulau Teluk Renjuna Community in Tumpat, Kelantan

25 August - 06 September 2013



Inter - cultural leadership and enterprise development exposes students from all over the world to the unique context of Pulau Teluk Renjuna community programme in the District of Tumpat, Kelantan, through multicultural teamwork and social entrepreneurship.

Participants will work in consultation and discussion with the villagers, to actively engage in social entrepreneurship by developing viable business plans, each to improve a specific village enterprise and to develop markets for its products. The students will be given the relevant information about the village and the region which will allow them to explore and develop different possibilities of assistance for the villagers and thereby changing their established mindsets. The business plans with proposals for village enterprise development will then be presented to the villagers and potential sponsors and financers, such as venture capitalists and bankers.

This Programme is co-organized by Universiti Malaysia Kelantan (UMK) and the Asia Research Centre (ARC) at the Chair for International Management (South East Asia), University of St. Gallen (HSG), Switzerland in collaboration with the ASEAN Learning Network (ALN).



Promoting Economic Development in the Target Village:

Students are encouraged to look for business and other sponsors to invest in appropriate production facilities, provide new markets for these products, new technology, and knowledge to improve business production methods and yields in the target village.

Cross-Cultural Leadership Development and Learning in a Real Life Asian Context:

Through this project, students will gain valuable experience in enterprise development in a unique Asian context. This context will develop their intercultural transformational leadership skills through working cross-culturally in a village as change agents and within an international and multicultural team. Students will also learn about the unique village contexts, the management approach and development of their conceptualized enterprises, and develop transformational leadership skills.

Continuous Cooperation and Contribution to Social Enterprise:

After the programme, students may continue to follow up with their work on a voluntary basis to bring about the fulfilment of their projects. The implementation of these projects takes place continuously with the assistance of UMK students in future SEED and other related programmes. These students can also recommend their friends to participate in this programme.



Participation is open to students (from outside Malaysia) with any disciplinary background but willing to learn cross-culturally. There are only about 20 places allocated for students from other universities. A number of places are already being allocated for students from the ASEAN Learning Network (ALN) universities.

International students in the programme will be joined by students from UMK and also the ALN universities to facilitate optimum cross-cultural learning.

The international students/participants arrive in Kota Bharu and will be received by UMK students and brought to UMK hostels for a rest, followed by Welcome Dinner at 8.00 pm.

This is to introduce participants to Malaysia and Kelantan, particularly, the SEED Programme in Malaysia, Tumpat District and the SEED village, so as to prepare the participants to work with the Pulau Teluk Renjuna SEED villagers.

☐ Wednesday, August 28 - Transfer to the SEED village, Meeting with village authorities and village visit (Homestay):

Participants will meet the District officers and village representative to get a brief explanation about the village, and visit a few village projects and household

☐ Thursday, August 29- Friday, August 30 - Village Familirazation and Data Gathering:

The participants will go to different assigned"Kampongs" in the village to do social mapping and to identify local business potential. During the session, participants will experience real village life with the local community. Thus, a comprehensive understanding of the local context is gained and new ideas will develop from this two-day stint. Participants are also expected to hold exploratory discussion with the villagers.


Saturday, August 31-Tuesday, Sept. 3- Focus Group Discussion (FGD), Business Plan Development with the villagers:

FGD will be focused to know villager's expectation and willingness to develop themselves and to discuss how economic development can be done based on their existing potentials. Through the development of a social enterprise project with the villagers, the students are able to help open the villagers' minds to new ideas from outside of their own culture to solve their problems


